



CONSECUTIVE BA / MBA (CBM) DEGREE PROGRAM

1. Regulation

The Consecutive BA/MBA (CBM) degree program affords undergraduate Business majors the opportunity to broaden their studies and improve their career prospects. Interested students should apply at the latest one semester before completing the BA program.

In our highly technical and globally competitive society, the MBA degree is frequently viewed as the professional "working degree" for many business career paths. The MBA degree can be a valuable tool to those who possess it by taking undergraduate studies to a deeper and broader level of knowledge and skills.

Benefits of enrollment in the Consecutive BA/MBA degree program include:

- Application fee waived for MBA program
- For qualified BA/MBA students, GRA/GTA appointments with a stipend, reduced tuition, and fees upon matriculation into the MBA program
- Elimination of early decision process uncertainty at graduation
- Up to 6- hour credit toward the MBA program as long as the MBA degree is conferred within two years of completing the BA degree.

Qualifications for this program are as follows:

- At the time of submission of the application for this program, the student must have an overall GPA of at least 3.5, with no single term GPA below 3.0, and must maintain a minimum 3.5 GPA through completion of the BA program.

Notes:

1. Depending on the level of demand, the required minimum GPA may increase.
2. For transfer students, the required GPA is based on a minimum of 24 hours of BA coursework after entering GCU and having a transfer GPA of 3.0 or higher from an approved accredited undergraduate program.
